## Long Range 8-Week Costume Plan

| Week 1 | Measurements  |
|--------|---|
|        | Meet the family<br>Take many photos and measurements of child in and out of the wheelchair<br>Sketches of costume   |
| Week 2 | Gather Supplies & Start Build   |
|        | Order your supplies, or pick up (Home Depot, Lowes, Menards, Hobby Lobby, etc.)<br>Build the Master Frame for the wheelchair  |
| Week 3 | Main Frame  |
|        | Build entire PVC frame<br>Make sure everything lines up and fits to the Master Frame<br>Test the 3 Rules and make changes if needed<br>• Light weight<br>• Fits through a doorway (aim for 28″)<br>• Easy to get the child in/out quickly |
| Week 4 | Glue & Paint Frame  |
|        | Glue entire frame with PVC glue (please note that frame will shrink slightly when you glue)<br>Make sure it still fits the Master Frame before the glue dries (30 seconds)<br>Paint the entire frame, all over and let it dry overnight   |
| Week 5 | Basic Skin  |
|        | Start building the skin of the costume around the PVC frame<br>If needed, use cardboard to build templates, then cut shapes out of material from<br>templates   |
| Week 6 | Detailed Skinning   |
|        | Add detailing with thinner skin material, or other material<br>Add texture if needed  |
| Week 7 | Paint & Lights  |
|        | Remove skin sections, and paint them. Let dry and put back on costume.<br>Add lights - keep in mind where to turn them on/off, and how costume comes apart  |
| Week 8 | Details   |
|        | Add vinyl stickers<br>Sound effects and speakers<br>Details and airbrushing if available  |
